Following are a variety of trips offered through our Fantasea Dive Shop. The Dive Shop hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. During these hours please visit the dive shop to inquire about or book tours. The front desk staff can also arrange tours and are available to assist when the dive shop is closed. We do our best to accommodate any request so don't hesitate to ask if an excursion you wish to do is not listed below.

Snorkeling Trips: In the crystal clear waters of Ambergris Caye non-divers can enjoy the beauty of the under water world. There are several sites to snorkel and skin-dive; Hol Chan Marine Reserve, Mexico Rocks and Coral Garden are all within a short boat ride for Victoria House. Equipment can be rented from the Fantasea Dive Shop located on the pier. Trips run every day at 9:00am or 2:00pm and last around 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours.

Two Stop Snorkel- Snorkel at Hol Chan Marine reserve in a beautiful channel filled with a variety of fish and coral. The second stop in at Shark Ray alley where you swim with nurse sharks and stingrays.

Cost- \$39.60 plus \$10.00 Hol Chan Park Fee/pp

Mexico Rocks- Snorkel at the northern part of Ambergris Caye. You will see brain coral, a variety of fish and possibly a squid or octopus.

Cost- \$46.20 /pp

Half day Charter- Up to four people in a private boat for snorkeling *locally*.

Cost-\$225.50 per boat

Full day Charter- Up to four people in a private boat for snorkeling at any nearby location, head to Caye Caulker for lunch and some afternoon snorkeling to follow. (Lunch is not included)

Cost- \$324.50 per boat

May be subject to \$10.pperson park fee (dependant upon snorkel location)

2 stop sail to Caye Caulker- Catamaran sailing trip to snorkel Hol Chan marine reserve and Shark Ray Alley. You will visit Caye Caulker for lunch (not included) and then sail back to San Pedro in the afternoon. Soft drinks and rum punch included. Minimum of 4 people. This is a full day trip.

Cost- \$82.50 /pp plus \$10.00 park fee/pp

Bacalar Chico- This Mayan National park and Marine Reserve is a snorkeler's paradise. An abundance of marine life will be seen on the tours three snorkeling stops. This is combined with visiting the ancient dug out canal dated over 1500 years old. Lunch is provided on Rocky Point, a spectacular area where the Barrier Reef meets Ambergris Caye. The trip leaves San Pedro at 9:00 am and returns at 4:30pm. Minimum of 6 persons.

Cost- \$104.50 /pp plus \$5.00 park fee/pp



Diving the Barrier Reef- Ambergris Caye is located West of the second largest Barrier reef in the world and boasts a variety of dive sites within a 20 minute boat ride. The atolls also offer an amazing full day of diving.

Refresher Course- The purpose of this program is to review and update the knowledge and skills of certified divers, particularly those who have had an extended period of inactivity in diving. Includes a review of dive theory, dive tables, safety diving practices, water-skills review and an open-water orientation dive. Proof of certification is required.

Cost: Refresher Course- \$88.00 /pp

Refresher course and one dive- \$159.50 /pp

Open Water Certification- This is a program designed to provide students with knowledge and skills necessary to dive safely. The course consists of 5 informal classroom sessions, 4 shallow water skill development dives and 4 open water dives at the reef. All necessary equipment and books are provided. At the completion of the course students will receive a PADI certification card, which allows them to participate in diving activities, and to rent and purchase scuba tanks and equipment. Minimum age 12.

Cost- \$475.00 /pp

Open water Referral- This is a two-day course for individuals who have already completed their academic and confined water requirements for the open water course. The course consists of the 4 open water dives required for the completion of the open water certification course. All necessary equipment is included. A student referral form from the original instructor is required. Minimum age 12.

Cost- \$330.00 /pp

Advanced Diver Certification- The Advanced open water course provides the novice diver with a structured well-supervised means to gain additional dive experience. An important prerequisite to many specialty courses, the course consists of 5 open water dives done over 2 days. Dives includes an underwater navigation dive and a night dive. Proof of certification is required.

Cost- \$412.50 /pp

Discover Scuba diving- This resort course is a one day program designed to allow non-divers to experience scuba diving under the direct supervision of a dive instructor. Includes a lecture on dive theory and safe diving practices, hands on equipment orientation and a shallow water practice session. This is followed by a well-supervised boat dive in a shallow reef environment. Shallow dives may be done with our qualified dive masters.

Minimum age 12.

Cost-\$203.50 /pp

Local Diving- These dives depart at 9.00am every day for the two tank dive and 2:00pm for the one tank dive. The boat ride is between 5 to 20 minutes from the dive shop to the dive site. Equipment is NOT included and proof of certification is required.

Two tank dive- \$82.50 /pp

One tank dive- \$71.50 /pp

One tank dive & one snorkel stop- \$77.00 /pp

Night dive- \$71.50 /pp (minimum of 4 people)

Marine Park Fees may apply dependant upon dive site

Offshore dive Trips- These trips depart at 5.30am and return to San Pedro at approximately 4.30/5:00pm. Included are three one tank dives, lunch and refreshments, equipment is NOT included and proof of certification is required.

Blue Hole- \$210.00 /pp + \$40.00 park fee

Mainland and Water Tours:

Lamanai- The ruins of Lamanai are located on the banks of the 30-mile long New River Lagoon in North Central Belize. The Lamanai Archaeological Reserve also contains a museum, the remnants of two 16th century Spanish Churches and a colonial sugar mill that was established in 1860. Set in a tropical forest and providing a unique experience in the culture of the Maya and the biological diversity of a tropical rainforest. This trip leaves at 7:00am and returns around 5:00pm if you travel by boat and 2:30pm if traveling by air.

Cost by Boat- \$148.50 /pp

Cost by air- \$212.80 /pp

Altun Ha- Named for the incredibly engineered "rock stone ponds" which gave the area life in the ancient times, Altun Ha is the site of the discovery of the largest solid jade head carving in the Maya World. The trip consists of a boat ride up the Northern River to Bomba Village. Transportation is provided to the site for a tour and then to the Maruba Jungle Lodge for lunch (not included in the trip) and the afternoon. Treatments can be arranged at Maruba's spa or you can relax by the pool and mineral baths. This trip leaves at 8:45am and returns at 5:00pm.

Cost- \$90.00 plus \$5.00 park fee/pp

Tikal Day Tour- Tikal is located in Guatemala and is the largest Mayan Ruin site in the world. This trip includes airfare to and from Flores Guatemala, lunch, a guided tour around the site as well as all transfers. It is a spectacular full day trip for those really interested in the Mayan civilization and ruins. This trip leaves at 7:00am and returns around 6:00pm.

Cost- \$402.00 plus \$33.00 departure fees/pp

Manatee Watching- This tour begins with a boat ride to view the manatees near St Georges Caye. From there the boat heads off to Goff's Caye, a tiny white sand island located right by the Barrier Reef, for a BBQ lunch and snorkeling right off the beach. Two additional snorkeling stops will follow and a stop by Caye Caulker on your way back to San Pedro. This trip leaves at 8:45 am and returns around 4:30pm.

Minimum of 6 persons. Cost- \$104.50 /pp plus \$15.00 park fee/pp.

Cave Tubing / Belize Zoo - This adventure begins with a trip over to Belize city either by boat or air, from there you are picked up and driven down the Western Highway to the cave system. Once on site there is a hike to the caves where the tubing begins. The cave tubing lasts about 2 ½ hours. Following this you will have lunch (provided and included) and then head off to the Belize Zoo for the afternoon. This is a full day trip leaving the island around 7:00am and returning around 5:00pm.

Cost- by boat: \$165.00 /pp plus \$5.00 park fee

Cave tubing by air: \$205.00 /pp plus \$5.00 park fee

Cave Tubing / Jungle Canopy Zip Line- Take place at Jaguar Paw Resort. The resort is located less than 50 minutes drive south of Belmopan. The trip starts from Victoria House Dock. Guests are picked up by boat; the boat ride is about 45 minutes to an hour. This depends on how much you see while going through the jungle river as guests enjoy a continental breakfast provided by the tour company. On arrival guests are allowed time to use the bathrooms and stretch their legs. Afterwards they are taken to the resort on a well-equipped van with air conditioner.

On arrival guests hike for 10 minutes to get to where the zip line will take place. The zip line adventure consists of 8 zip line platforms each strategically located within the rainforest canopy. Double cables (each capable of withstanding 2,000 pounds of weight, the requirement for this tour truly has nothing to do with weight but with the size of the safety equipment) are used for the ultimate safety. All landing platforms are equipped with safety gear, handrails and guides to meet your next landing as well as to ensure your personal safety throughout the tour. The platforms are as high as 85ft into the canopy and as far apart as 250ft!

Guests head to the restaurant to have lunch that is also provided by the company. When guest have finished with lunch and rested for a while guests get ready for the cave tubing. The guides equip the guests with the tube and the headlights. The hiking takes about 30 minutes to get to the caves itself. The river is like a lazy river, all guests do is lay on the tube and the river takes you to a great experience inside the caves. Guests get to see the crystalline stalactites and it is a fascinating experience to be inside the caves when it is raining. The cave tubing takes about 2 hours to 2 hours and a half.

When everybody has changed into dry clothes guests head back to San Pedro through the same routine.

Fishing- The guides used at Victoria House have lived their lives on the island and are very knowledgeable about their surroundings and the fishing. Price includes the guide, equipment (for the Flats a fly rod or for the Reef a spinning rod), gas, tackle, cooler with ice sodas and water. Box lunches are available upon request from the dining room for full day fishing trips.

Times - $\frac{1}{2}$ Day (morning) 8:00am to 11:30/12:00 noon
- $\frac{1}{2}$ Day (afternoon) 1:30pm to 5:00 pm
- Full day is 8:00am to 2:30/3:00pm

Flats fishing- When fishing the flats you will be in a small narrow boat called a Lanchon. The length of boats used on the flats runs from 20 to about 24 feet, and about 5 to 6 feet across. You fish off a platform on the bow of the boat for the best visibility. Once on the flats the guides cuts off the engine and prepares his guest on the deck to fish while he poles the boat through the flats. The bonefish flats are about 25-40 minutes on the leeward side of the island and you leave off our dock with the best guides on the island.

Cost- 1/2-day \$225.50 per boat (1 to 2 people)
Full day-\$324.50 per boat (1 to 2 people)

Reef Fishing- At the reef we bottom fish with live sardines for snapper's horse eye jacks, mackerel, barracuda, and groupers. After your trip you can bring your fresh caught fish to the dining room and have it prepared for lunch or dinner (fish prep is an additional dining room charge).

Cost- 1/2 day \$225.50 per boat (1 to 4 people)
Full day- \$324.50 per boat (1 to 4 people)

Deep Sea Fishing- The boats used for this trip are 32-36 foot boats and are equipped with a cabin, bathroom, and a fighting chair. You will fish for Wahoo, Blue Marlin, Sailfish or maybe a King Fish. These boats allow for up to 5 lines out at the same time, and who knows you may have a bite on every line.

Cost- 1/2 day \$495.00 per boat (1 to 4 people)
Full day \$715.00 per boat (1 to 4 people)

Fish/bbq/Snorkel or fish/bbq/fish- The trip begins at 8:30am. At the reef we bottom fish with live sardines for snapper's, horse eye jacks, mackerel, barracuda, and groupers. After you catch enough you head up north to a beach bar. The guide will BBQ the fish for you. After lunch you head out to the reef again to either fish some more or snorkel.

Cost-\$379.50 maximum 4 people
\$104.50 pp if more than 4 people



Other Fun Activities.

Birding- A variety of birds may be observed in the immediate vicinity of Victoria House Resort, but a forty minute boat ride to the leeward side of Ambergris Caye will introduce you to the many birds indigenous to the area. After the birding you may choose to stop off for a refreshing snorkel. This trip is a half-day leaving between 8:00 and returning at 11:30.

Cost- \$60.50 /pp (min of 4 people) or private charter \$225.50

Sunset Sails- See the sunset from the Caribbean Sea on your own private boat. Sunset sails can be set up any evening for a romantic end to the perfect sunny day. The boat will pick you up at the Victoria House pier at 5:30 and return from the sail around 7:30. Champagne on board can be arranged,(2 persons)!

Cost- \$192.50 per boat

Golf- South of Ambergris Caye is a private island made just for golfers. Caye Chapel boasts an 18-hole course and clubhouse. The day includes flights to the island, unlimited golfing for the day, club rental, golf cart, private beach, heated pool, therapeutic hot tub and pool side snacks.

Cost- \$220.00 /pp
